

Library Conduct Policy

The Chalmer Davee Library is dedicated to advancing the university's culture of learning by providing authoritative resources and professional services, and supports the teaching, learning and research efforts of UWRF students, faculty, staff, and the community. All users must conduct themselves in a manner that does not disturb other patrons, disrupt the operation of the library or cause damage to the library, its equipment and materials. All users must abide by applicable sections of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, any relevant local, state and federal laws and comply with all library and university policies.

Library computers are for priority use by University of Wisconsin-River Falls students, faculty, and staff. Library staff may limit the time on kiosks. Anyone not affiliated with the University found to be using a computer that requires a Falcon Account, must relinquish it immediately. Such use constitutes a violation of the [University Falcon Account policy](#).
